Matters arising from the last minutes	The executive committee met with the advisory board on October 3 rd , they discussed the resolution from the 2021 convention, in which we made a motion and agreed to relax the clause in the constitution (artcle 4 section 4) and allow two officials from the Arthur Welwean administration (James Garwo and Mother Sally Lappia) to continue in their respective roles as Treasurer and Chaplain, respectively.
	Dr. Will Jallah made a motion for the two officials from Arthur Welwean Administration to remain in their respective roles until the next election. Motion seconded by Rev. Wyston Dixon.
	President Kieh tested the motion of Dr. Will Jallah; restated by Lucretia Davis, and seconded by Nat Sumo. Yea: 43 Nay: 0 N/A: 2 Abstained: 1
Project	Chairman Daniel Kieh informed the general body that
Committee Update	as of Friday October 29 the roof had been completed.
	Next phase is installation of the metal door and the burglar bars on 36 windows. After that is completed will come the electrical work, the plumbing, tiling and lastly the ceiling.
	Enoch Nah requested a total cost for the first few phases of the project.

	Motion to adopt the monthly financial report was made by Vice-President Cecelia S Kukor Brown, seconded by Cecelia Wilson-Kokuloku.
Update From Region 1	Daniel Kieh provided an update on the plan for Region I to host the 2022 AFIRA convention on the East Coast.
	We have secured a hall in Philadelphia for the business session and the ball that will cost \$1250. They have another hall in Maryland that is available on July 29 and 30, 2022 and will cost \$1500 (\$750/day). Unfortunately this weekend won't work beause the constitution requires the convention to be held on the second weekend in July.
	President Kieh suggested taking this offline for discussion between the executive committee, the advisory board and region 1.
Other Matters	President Kieh thanked the membership & mobilization committee and everyone who has so far participated in the 1 bring 1 challenge from the 2021 Minnesota Convention.
	In President Kieh's inaugural address he stated he would raise membership by 25% in the first 90 days and the 1 bring 1 program helped achieve that goal. Based on the baseline membership of approximately 31 members before the initiation of this recruitment effort, AFIRA would have needed to add about 7 members to meet the promise in the 4 point Plan of Action (4POA) of the new administration. We are delighted to announce that we have recruited 11 new members so far - meeting and exceeding our commitment.
